## AMBL90

- Biodiversity, Ecology and Evolution -

4-6 March 2019

Venue: AMBL-KU, Amakusa, Japan



"AMBL90" is a special international symposium to be held at the Amakusa Marine Biological Laboratory, Kyushu University, Japan, for scientists engaged in any field of research on biodiversity, ecology and evolution, including taxonomic/phylogenetic studies and conservation issues. Participants are welcome to present one oral presentation each. The total number of participants will be controlled to encourage active scientific debate in a congenial atmosphere.

4 March 13:00 - Sessions (including special lectures)
5 March 9:00 - Sessions (symposium dinner 18:00 -)

6 March Full-day workshop/excursion (weather permitting)

Registration charge: JPY 12,000 or USD 100 (including a symposium dinner). (To be paid on arrival. There is no discount for not attending the dinner)

Accommodation is to be paid separately by each participant and will be arranged locally. Non-Japanese participants and students will be given priority to stay at the AMBL dormitory (shared facilities), if they prefer this option to staying at local hotels/inns.

Registration is open now until the 2<sup>nd</sup> of February. However, earlier registration is strongly recommended in order to avoid disappointment, as the maximum number of participants will be controlled due to space limitation. (Those not requiring accommodation can register until the 28<sup>th</sup> February)

## Registration procedures:

- 1 Full name, as it appears on your passport
- 2 Affiliation (if none, just state so)
- 3 Accommodation preference (hotel / inn / dormitory / own arrangement)

  (If sharing, list the names with whom you prefer sharing)

  Japanese participants are encouraged to make own arrangements.
- 4 Dates accommodation is required (Indicate the day of arrival/departure).
